

## **Tournament Rules Milolii Classic**

### Fishing Area

Fishing permitted from Kiholo Bay, north to Ka lae point, South.

### Start Line

All boats must start EACH DAY from the designated start line in front of Milolii Pier. Late starts must come to the boat harbor pier.

### Weigh ins

- All fish must be weighed on the day caught.
- Fish must be brought at Milolii pier by water, not trucked in.
- All fish must be weighed at the Milolii pier by an official weigh master
- All fish on board must be weighed in 1 hour after end of tournament, except for those still fighting fish at the end of tournament.

### Minimum Qualifying Weights

- Marlin 200 lbs
- Ahi 50 lbs
- Mahimahi 15 lbs
- Ono 15 lbs

### Fighting Fish

Fighting fish in Pole holder allowed.

### Line

Any # test allowed for fishing line.

### Reels

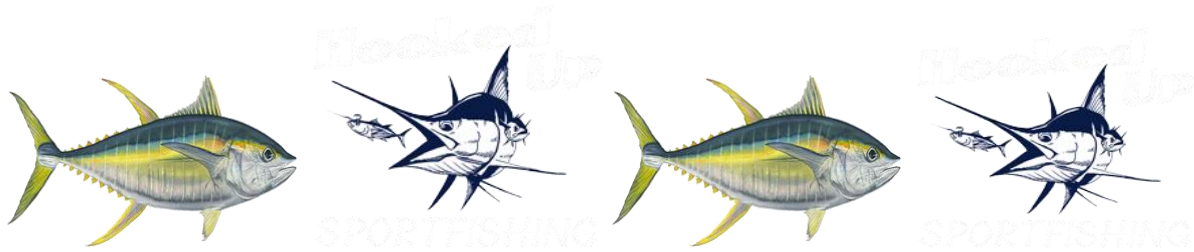
Power driven reels of any kind are PROHIBITED. This includes hydraulic motor reels, electric reels, or any device that gives the angler an unfair advantage of reels designed to be cranked with both hands at the same time are PROHIBITED.

### Tag and Release

No Tag and Release in Milolii Classic

### Ties

In case of a fish of equal weight, the first fish weighed in first shall win.



### Live Bait is Permitted

Bait caught for live bait or chum must be caught after start fishing each day. No dead or live bait allowed on boat until after start fishing. No passing of any bait between boats.

## **Fishing Rules**

Day 1 Fishing: 7 am - 4 pm

Roundups: 10 am, 1 pm

Day 2 Fishing 7am – 3 pm

Roundups: 10 am, 1 pm

## **Fish Disqualification**

### Mutilation

Mutilation of the fish, such as bites from sharks, mammals, propeller damage, or anything that would seriously affect the fighting ability of the fish.

### Not Reported

Fish either not called into Tournament control or not reported in round up.

### Loss of Communication

In case a team loses total VHF radio and phone contact with Tournament Control they must be at the pier prior to stop fishing in order for their fish to qualify.

## **Team Disqualification**

### Cheating

- Using a green stick
- Fireman(s) including a bang stick

### Not securing

You must secure daily with tournament control. This is for your safety. If you do not secure, we will assuming you are in distress and call the coast guard for assistance.
